The Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Central District of California is accepting applications for the position of Investigator / Mitigation Specialist in the Capital Habeas Unit (CHU).

Exceptional interviewing skills, as well as excellent verbal and writing skills are a must. The Investigator/Mitigation Specialist conducts guilt and penalty phase investigation with special attention to legally relevant mental health, environmental, and social, mitigating factors. The applicant must be able to work collaboratively to achieve the goals of legal representation.

Must possess a valid driver's license and an insured personal vehicle. This position requires extensive travel, varying hours including nights and weekends. Fluency in Spanish (verbal and written) are preferred but not required. A background in mental health or social services are highly valued. Computer literacy is a must.
