The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is seeking a full time Assistant Computer Systems Administrator (ACSA) in our Tallahassee office. The Federal Public Defender provides federal criminal defense services to individuals unable to afford counsel.

The ACSA assists with user support, user training, and the resolution of hardware, software, and data communications problems as well as litigation support by analyzing, identifying litigation support needs, creating and maintaining case management and trial presentation databases, working with vendors, and researching latest methods and technologies.

The ACSA assists and reports directly to the Supervisory Computer Systems Administrator located in Tallahassee. The ACSA will also provide support for our branch office in Gainesville with occasional travel to the branch office in Pensacola.

Tallahassee is Florida's Capital City and home to the Florida State University Seminoles and the Florida A&M University Rattlers. Tallahassee has something for everyone, whether it be bike and nature trails, state parks, museums, college sports, and more.
