The Federal Public Defender is accepting applications for the position of Mitigation Investigator at the Little Rock Office in the Capital Habeas Unit. Applicants must have three years of general experience with a demonstrated ability to obtain comprehensive social histories on death-sentenced inmates - - including document collection and retrieval, witness location and interview, report writing and data entry. The workload is heavy, and extensive travel is required. Salary will be based on qualifications and experience. Federal benefits apply.

Applicants must also have three years of specialized investigative experience. An undergraduate college degree with an overall “B” grade point average may be counted for one year of this specialized experience. Completion of one year of graduate study in fields such as sociology, psychology, or law will count for one year of specialized experience. Completion of a master’s degree or two years of graduate study in a field such as sociology, psychology, or law will count for two years of specialized experience.
