Experience investigating, analyzing, developing and presenting the mitigation evidence that exists in the life history of clients and gathering and summarizing social history records is recommended. **Ability to speak fluent Spanish is strongly preferred.** Willing to consider entry level candidates with Spanish-Speaking ability and a college degree. Successful applicants should have a college degree in the criminal justice field and/or social work.
