The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is seeking an Investigator for the FPD's branch office in Pensacola. This is a position in the office's trial unit.

The Investigator is an integral part of a team of attorneys, paralegal(s), and support staff. Duties include the ability to gather information; locate and interview witnesses; prepare comprehensive written reports; request records; testify in court; communicate with clients; and summarize voluminous documents. Additionally, investigating mitigation, including mental health history and personal and family

history, is a necessary skill for the position. Applicants must have strong organizational skills and broad familiarity with computer programs.

To qualify, the applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent and have at least three years of investigative experience and a valid driver's license. A four-year college degree is highly desirable. Criminal defense experience is preferred.
