The Paralegal will be responsible for all aspects of case preparation and file management; drafting pleadings and correspondence; maintaining attorneys' calendars of court dates and filing deadlines; preparing appellate briefs to the appropriate courts; answering general telephone inquiries regarding attorneys' activities; reviewing outgoing documents for accuracy; performing conflict checks; and assigning panel attorneys to incoming conflict cases.
