ORDER

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum, it is hereby Ordered that:

1. The motion for imposition of a reduced sentence (ECF 1036) is Granted;
2. The sentence previously imposed in the Judgment & Commitment Order docketed on February 6, 2012, (ECF 751), is reduced to Time Served in the custody of the Bureau of Prisons;
3. The defendant shall be released from the Volunteers of America on March 30, 2020;
4. The previously imposed conditions of supervised release remain in effect, with the following additional conditions:
 - a. The defendant shall be in home confinement at an address preapproved by the U.S. Probation Office and subject to location monitoring in the discretion of the U.S. Probation Office for a period of 90 days;
 - b. During the period of home confinement, the defendant shall not leave the house for any purpose other than medical or other emergencies, with the prior approval of the U.S. Probation Office; and
 - c. The defendant shall comply with all directives of federal, state, and local government officials relating to public health, including COVID-19.
