COVID-19 Home Confinement Information

BOP began immediately reviewing all inmates who have COVID-19 risk factors, as described by the CDC, to determine which inmates are suitable for home confinement. Since the release of the Attorney General's original memo to the Bureau of Prisons on March 26, 2020 instructing us to prioritize home confinement as an appropriate response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the BOP has placed an additional 1,280 inmates on home confinement.

The BOP has **143,707** federal inmates in BOP-managed institutions and **10,226** in community-based facilities. The BOP staff complement is approximately **36,000**. As of 04/19/2020, there are **495** federal inmates and **309** BOP staff who have confirmed positive test results for COVID-19 nationwide. Currently, **155** inmates and **29** staff have recovered. There have been **22** federal inmate deaths and **0** BOP staff member deaths attributed to COVID-19 disease.

Due to the rapidly evolving nature of this public health crisis, the BOP will update the open COVID-19 confirmed positive test numbers and the number of COVID-19 related deaths daily at 3:00 p.m. The positive test numbers are based on the most recently available **confirmed lab results** involving open cases from across the agency as reported by the BOP's Office of Occupational Health and Safety. BOP field sites may report additional updates throughout the day. Data is subject to change based on additional reporting.
