

Recommendation

Mr. Powell is 55-years-old, suffers from several respiratory problems (including asthma and sleep apnea), and has less than 3 months remaining on his 262-month sentence—he is set to be released on June 16, 2020. Given the current COVID-19 global pandemic and the parties' joint request, the Court recommends that the Bureau of Prisons immediately place Samuel Powell into home confinement to serve the remainder of his prison term under the following conditions:

- 1) That Mr. Powell reside at his mother's residence, Sandra Powell, in Washington, DC.
- 2) That he be confined to the home—except when attending medical appointments or other activities approved by the U.S. Probation Office—until the end of his prison term.
- 3) That he report to the U.S. Probation Office as directed.
- 4) That he not violate any federal, state, or local laws.
