**GENERAL ORDER 21-03** 

## **ORDER**

On April 8, 2020, this Court entered General Order 20-07, which temporarily closed the public clerk's office counters in the Rome and Gainesville divisions of the Court due to the Coronavirus pandemic and COVID-19. At that time, the configuration of the public counters in those divisions did not allow for adequate separation of individuals submitting in-person filings from clerk's office staff and there was no COVID-19 vaccination. Since that time, the public counters in Rome and Gainesville have been reconfigured with physical barriers that provide adequate separation. In addition, a large segment of the public and court staff have now received the COVID-19 vaccinations.

Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that General Order 20-07 is rescinded effective June 1, 2021, and the Rome and Gainesville public counters shall reopen on that date.
