WAIVER OF PERSONAL

I hereby acknowledge that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142, I have the right to a detention hearing and, further, that I have a right to attend that detention hearing in person. However, due to the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) within the Middle District of Alabama, which has resulted in the President of the United States' declaring a national emergency and the Governor of Alabama's declaring a state public health emergency, I hereby waive my right to attend my detention hearing in person and request that the Court allow me to attend by videoconference. I understand that my attorney will be allowed to question witnesses by videoconference, and I specifically waive the right to confront any such witnesses *in person* at the hearing.
