
FIFTH AMENDED SPECIAL ORDER NO. 13-12

**COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES
CREATED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

The court will follow CDC guidelines that recommend wearing a well-fitting face mask indoors in public when the COVID-19 community level is designated as “High.” During a period of high transmission in Dallas County, anyone who enters the Earle Cabell Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, including, but not limited to, employees, jurors, witnesses, attorneys, interpreters, and contractors, must wear a face covering while in a public space, including a courtroom, unless otherwise instructed by a judge, authorized court official, or law enforcement. Information about face covering requirements will be posted on signage throughout the building and on the court’s website.
