this District to do so via U.S. Mail, email or fax. Said General Order 20-05 is fully adopted as a part

hereof by reference as though set forth herein verbatim.

Unless extended or earlier terminated by subsequent order of this Court, this General Order

(and General Order 20-05 which is extended hereby) will remain in effect hereafter through August

31, 2020 but the same will otherwise expire automatically on September 1, 2020 and without further

action.
