Prior to your visit to the Courthouse, please take note that all persons entering the U.S. Courthouse are subject to the provisions of this Court's General Order Regarding the Continuity of Operations and Courthouse Accessibility which requires visitors to wear a mask.

The Court will continue to conduct video conferencing in civil and criminal cases and each judge will decide what matters will be held in-person and what matters will be held remotely. Parties are encouraged to continue to consent to and participate in video conferencing.
