Public Counter Hours


In March 2021, the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts will resume jury trials and in-person proceedings. The listing of current trials and court hearings is available on our electronic [CourtList](#). On days when there is an in-person hearing or trial, the public counter will be open for visitor access at the federal courthouses in Springfield, Worcester, and Boston.

While the Clerk's Office of the U.S. District Court in each building remains open during regular business hours, the public counters will open at 9 a.m. and close at 2 p.m. to permit the limited personnel in each office to complete necessary administrative business in a timely manner each day. The Clerk's Office maintains a public filing box in the lobby of each courthouse and filings can be placed in the box during business hours. Documents are retrieved every workday at 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. The filing process will be completed upon entry onto the official docket of the court.
