



COVID-19 BUILDING REQUIREMENTS

- **Entry Restrictions:** Entry is prohibited if you have been diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19 and have not completed the recommended period of isolation or if you have COVID-19 symptoms (temperature of 100.4 degrees or more, chills, cough, difficulty breathing, unusual fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea).
- **Masking:**
 - Masks are required in public areas when the CDC's most recent "Community Level" rating for Richmond is "High." (see <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/covid-by-county.html>).
 - Masks are required in public areas during weeks when the Fourth Circuit has announced a mask requirement protocol for oral arguments. (see <https://www.ca4.uscourts.gov/covid-19-announcements>).
 - Masking within private space shall be in accordance with the requirements established by each office or chambers.
 - Masks are available from the security officers at the building entrances.
