## STANDING ORDER 2023-2

The Court continues to monitor the local and national emergency occasioned by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all persons wear a face covering in public or indoor settings in areas where COVID-19 Community Levels are HIGH. In accordance with the CDC's COVID-19 Community Levels model, which became effective on February 25, 2022, and due to the recent surge of COVID-19 cases due to the current XBB.1.5. variant, Standing Order 2022-8 is AMENDED, in part, as follows:

- 1. All persons in a federal courthouse in the Western District of Virginia, including fully vaccinated persons, must wear a face covering in public spaces in the courthouse when Community Levels are HIGH in the city or county where the courthouse is located based on the CDC's COVID-19 County Check Tool located on the CDC website.
- The Clerk is DIRECTED to check the COVID-19 County Check Tool located on 2. the CDC website weekly and communicate with the Court Security Officers, Clerk's Office, Probation Office, and judge's chambers in each divisional courthouse as to COVID-19 Community Level in the city or county where the courthouse is located.
- 3. When the CDC COVID-19 County Check Tool on the CDC website indicates that the Community Level in the city or county where the courthouse is located is HIGH,

the Clerk and Court Security Officers are DIRECTED to ensure that signage is

posted by the General Services Administration at the entrance to the courthouse

indicating that Community Levels are HIGH and that masks are required in all public

spaces in the courthouse. Court Security Officers shall inform those entering the

courthouse of this Order and shall enforce it by excluding any person from the

building who does not comply with its requirements. The Court Security Officers

shall provide any person barred from entering a building with a list of telephone

numbers for the agencies in the building.

4. If the CDC COVID-19 County Check Tool indicates that the Community Level is

below the HIGH level for the city or county where the courthouse is located, the

mask requirement in public spaces is lifted.

5. Mask wearing during court proceedings and in judges' chambers in courthouses shall

be at the discretion of the presiding judge.

It is so ORDERED.
