IN RE: WEAPONS INSP SCREENING IN THIS DISTRICT

2017-03

It is hereby ordered that, effective immediately, the policy set forth in Local Rule IA 2-1 is amended as follows. Unless provided by special court order, no person may carry or possess firearms or other deadly weapons in any United States courthouse in this district without the express approval of the Chief District Judge. In addition, the presiding judge may permit a person to carry a firearm into the courtroom, but only after notifying the United States Marshals Service for the District of Nevada ("USMS").

The following are exempt from this order: United States Federal Judges in Nevada; the United States Marshal, Deputy United States Marshals, and Special Deputy United States Marshals assigned to the District of Nevada, and law enforcement or corrections officers assigned to operations or activities led by the USMS in the District of Nevada; United States Probation and Pretrial Service Officers; and Officers of the Federal Protective Service and security officers contracted by the Federal Protective Service assigned to courthouses in the District of Nevada.

For clarity, this policy applies to all federal courthouses in the District of Nevada. DATED THIS 7th Day of December 2022.
