Amending Entry Protocols and Rescinding
Social Distancing Protocols in Public Areas
of the Courthouse Building

GENERAL ORDER

No. 22-0014


This general order amends protocols relating to entry into the courthouse building and supersedes those provisions of General Order 21-0011 relating to social distancing protocols in the public areas of the courthouse.

Effective May 31, 2022, the following persons are not permitted to enter the District Court of Guam:

1. Persons who have been diagnosed with (or tested positive for) COVID-19 within the previous ten (10) days; and
2. Persons who are ill and displaying symptoms consistent with a flu, such as fever, body aches, sore throat, cough, and shortness of breath.

On May 2, 2022, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) issued Guidance Memorandum 2022-12 which specifies: "Congregations and social gatherings shall be permitted for both indoor and outdoor activities without numerical limitations." Accordingly, effective May 31, 2022, adherence to six (6) feet social distancing measures in the public areas of the courthouse shall not be required.
