OPERATIONS IN RESPONSE  
TO COVID-19 OUTBREAK

This General Order is issued in further response to the developing outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). On April 30, 2020, the Honorable Lourdes Leon Guerrero, Governor of Guam, issued Executive Order No. 2020-11 stating that, “All essential businesses and government agencies shall require that their employees and patrons shall wear face masks while on their premises.”

Given the Governor of Guam’s mandatory requirement to wear face coverings in public, effective immediately, absent further order of the Court, all tenants and visitors/patrons (public, media, etc.) entering the District Court of Guam courthouse and U.S. Probation and Pretrial Services offices must wear a face covering in all common areas and whenever they are within six-feet of another individual while on the premises. This Order does not remove or alter any other visitor restrictions set forth in General Order No. 20-0018.


