- 5. Sealed portions of Change of Plea transcripts discussing the defendant's cooperation;
- 6. Sealed portions of Sentencing transcripts discussing the defendant's cooperation;
- 7. Rule 35 Motions referencing the defendant's cooperation;
- 8. Responses to sealed Rule 35 Motions; and
