17	commence on or before January 31, 2022, were continued unless ordered otherwise
18	by the assigned judge. This date is hereby extended through February 11, 2022.
19	• General Order 22-02 also directed all criminal proceedings before Magistrate
20	Judges, such as initial appearances, detention hearings, and arraignments, be
21	conducted using audio and video conference technology until January 31, 2022,
22	unless the Magistrate Judge made the determination the proceedings must be
23	conducted in person at the courthouse. This date is hereby extended through
24	February 11, 2022.
25	The Court will revisit these procedures prior to February 11, 2022.
