
GENERAL ORDER 22-04

This General Order will address a temporary change in Court policy. All procedures in General Order 22-02 shall remain in effect with the following exceptions:

- Pursuant to General Order 22-02, all civil and criminal jury trials scheduled to commence on or before January 31, 2022, were continued unless ordered otherwise by the assigned judge. This date is hereby extended through **February 11, 2022**.
- General Order 22-02 also directed all criminal proceedings before Magistrate Judges, such as initial appearances, detention hearings, and arraignments, be conducted using audio and video conference technology until January 31, 2022, unless the Magistrate Judge made the determination the proceedings must be conducted in person at the courthouse. This date is hereby extended through **February 11, 2022**.

The Court will revisit these procedures prior to February 11, 2022.
