IN RE: ENDING MOST RESTRICTIONS TO COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED BY COVID-19 AND RELATED CORONAVIRUS

GENERAL ORDER 2022-07 VACATING TEMPORARY GENERAL ORDER 2020-03

In response to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") in the District of Nevada, the Court issued a series of general orders addressing the Court's efforts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. See Temporary General Orders 2020-02, 2020-03, 2020-04, 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-9.¹ One of those orders, Temporary General Order 2020-03, focused on jury trials, first suspending them and then, as amended, eventually allowing jury trials to resume as the Court reopened. As the Court has now mostly resumed normal operations, the Court issues this order vacating Temporary General Order 2020-03.
