RESCISSION OF GENERAL ORDER NO. 638 MAGISTRATE JUDGES' POLICY RE VACCINATION OF ALL INDIVIDUALS APPEARING BEFORE THE COURT IN THE SACRAMENTO DIVISION

On November 2, 2021, this court entered General Order No. 638 requiring all individuals appearing before any Magistrate Judge of the Eastern District of California in the area served by the Robert T. Matsui U.S. Courthouse in Sacramento, including Redding, to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, unless otherwise ordered by the judge presiding over a proceeding in a particular case.

The policy requiring full-vaccination and General Order No. 638 are hereby rescinded effective April 4, 2022. Each judge thereafter will determine vaccine mandates and masking requirements for his or her courtroom.
