GENERAL ORDER 21-0003


WHEREAS, there are currently in the Qualified Jury Wheel, One-Thousand Two-Hundred Seventy-Five (1,275) prospective jurors as required by the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, as Amended, and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a new Pool to appear for jury service on March 3, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. The term of service for prospective jurors shall be a fixed period not to exceed sixty (60) consecutive days, unless extended by order of the Chief Judge for the purpose of completing jury service in a particular case.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Wednesday, February 17, 2021, the Clerk of Court or her designated deputy clerks shall withdraw, by a purely randomized method, One-Hundred (100) names from the Qualified Jury Wheel who will be summoned for jury service on Wednesday, March 3, 2021 at 8:00 a.m.

A copy of this order shall be posted on the Court's bulletin board.
