## MISCELLANEOUS GENERAL ORDER 21-10

On March 31, 2021, the Court issued Miscellaneous General Order 21-09 Easing Restrictions on Court Proceedings. As discussed in MGO 21-09 the Court anticipates and the parties should be prepared for criminal and civil jury trials proceeding on a limited basis beginning May 3, 2021.

**Therefore, on or before April 9, 2021**, counsel in all pending criminal matters shall confer and submit a joint status report that will address the following:

- Whether the Court should prioritize the matter for trial. The Court has identified several factors it will evaluate in considering which cases should be given priority, such as:
  - 1. Proximity of time served in-custody and presumptive guideline range;
  - 2. Speedy Trial Act expiration;
  - 3. Complexity of matter;
  - 4. Ability for counsel to meaningfully interact with defendant in preparation of trial;
  - 5. Length of time in-custody; and
  - 6. Availability of counsel.

Counsel shall confer and advise the court on the applicable factors affecting the case.

- Whether the parties are ready to proceed to trial as soon as May 3, 2021. If one or both of the parties indicate that a May 3, 2021 trial date is not feasible, the parties shall provide a rationale for additional delay as well as three proposed trial dates agreeable to all parties.
- An estimate of the anticipated length of trial, noting that the Court has adopted safeguards and precautions that will likely result in atypical delays.
- What other issues, if any, remain to be resolved before the start of trial, such as motions in limine, discovery disputes or other pretrial litigation.
- Whether the parties anticipate the virtual participation of any witness during trial.

• Any other information that might assist the Court in identifying potential issues relating to conducting the trial in a matter the conforms with the precautions discussed above.
