

ALL IN-PERSON, IN-COURT PROCEEDINGS SUSPENDED UNTIL FEBRUARY 16, 2021

Due to state and local stay home orders, the court has suspended all in-person, in-court proceedings (with the exception of [grand jury proceedings](#)) at all Northern District of California courthouses. This suspension will remain in effect through February 15, 2021, with a planned resumption of some limited proceedings, if possible, on February 16, 2021.
