



Chief Judge Order No. 59

On June 10, 2020, upon the recommendations of the Strategic Committee on Resumption of Regular Court Proceedings, the Chief Judge issued Chief Judge Order (CJO) 29, which adopted certain safety protocols for in-person proceedings conducted in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California. Many of the circumstances giving rise to the COVID-19 public emergency have not abated. To continue to protect the public's safety and prevent the spread of COVID-19, this Order hereby re-adopts and extends the safety protocols set forth in CJO 29. This Order is effective immediately and will remain in place until further order of the Court.
