RETURN TO IN-PERSON ATTORNEY ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS GENERAL ORDER NO. 163

WHEREAS, consistent with this District's Local Rule of Civil Procedure 83.1, all attorneys

seeking permanent admission to practice in this Court must appear in person before a judge of this

Court to be admitted;

WHEREAS, because of the COVID-19 pandemic, that requirement was suspended, most

recently by a General Order issued on July 14, 2021 (General Order No. 148), that—among other

things—authorized the judges in this District, at their discretion, to waive the personal appearance

of an applicant for attorney admission and his or her sponsor and to perform the admission through

any available communication technology;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is no longer appropriate to suspend the

requirements of an in-person appearance as set forth in Local Rule of Civil Procedure 83.1;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the provision of General Order No. 148 authorizing

remote attorney admission proceedings is hereby vacated, and all future attorney admission

proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with this District's Local Rules of Civil Procedure.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
