DIRKSEN COURTHOUSE COVID-19 Precautions

The Court takes your safety very seriously. The following precautions have been put in place in the Dirksen Courthouse to lessen the risk of the virus.

- All visitors to the Dirksen Courthouse will **enter** through the north revolving door on Dearborn St. All **exit** from the building will be through the Quincy Street exits. If you are disabled, please enter through the sliding glass doors on Dearborn Street. You will then proceed to the north screening station. The south screening station will be temporarily closed.
- Observe **social distancing** while waiting to be screened at the security stations.
- All visitors to the Courthouse are required to wear **face coverings** in all public places including courtrooms unless excused by the judge presiding. A copy of the Order can be found [HERE](#). If you do not have a mask, you will be provided with one at the security screening station.
- **Elevator** cars are restricted to two occupants per car. There will be markers to tell you where to stand in the elevators for social distancing purposes.
- The Court has provided **disinfectant sanitizing stations and wipes** through out the Courthouse for your use.
- The Courthouse is being regularly cleaned and disinfected and high touch areas are cleaned more frequently.
- If you are **sick**, have a **fever** above 100.4 degrees or are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please do not enter the Courthouse. Click [HERE](#) for further information.

- The **cafeteria** in the Courthouse is closed until further notice.
