The undersigned being sufficiently advised, and it is hereby

ORDERED that, effective this date, paragraph 6 of General Order 18-22 is **AMENDED** as follows:

6. All criminal cases on the Lexington and Frankfort dockets, absent other agreement by the participating active and/or senior judges, shall be referred by blind draw to United States Magistrate Judge Matthew A. Stinnett (70%) and United States Magistrate Judge Edward B. Atkins (30%). Should Magistrate Judge Stinnett recuse, the matter shall be reassigned to Magistrate Judge Atkins. Should Magistrate Judge Atkins recuse, the matter shall be reassigned to United States Magistrate Judge Hanly A. Ingram.

Except as previously amended by General Order 19-12, all other provisions of General Order 18-22 remain in place.
