Witnesses. Contract court reporters. Any other individual specifically authorized by the presiding judge. 					
In Accordance with SO-20-19 The Following Visitors May Not Enter Any Courthouse in EDTN	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Had been advised to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency within the last 14 days Has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or told to presume they have COVID-19 by a health professional within the last 14 days Has had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or told to presume they have COVID-19 by a health professional - unless diagnosis was more than 14 days ago and the person diagnosed has been symptom-free for the past 72 hours Has had the following symptoms within last 14 days, not attributed to another known condition: cough, shortness of breath, fever of 100.4 or higher, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, or extreme fatigue Has returned from international travel, or a cruise ship or a river voyage within last 14 days Has been released within the last 14 days from federal, state or local jail, prison or other correctional institution - except those reporting to be fitted with a location monitoring device or those under halfway house supervision. 					
In Accordance to SO-20-19 All Visitors Entering Any Courthouse in EDTN Must Pass through Entry Screening	<p>Entry Screening includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Pass through contactless temperature scanner Wear a mask made with at least two layers of breathable material that fully covers the nose and mouth, is secure under the chin, fits snugly but comfortably against side of face, and is secured with ties or ear loops. The following are not permitted: face shields, neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas, face coverings containing valves, and mesh material or holes of any kind. Masks will be available for anyone not wearing a compliant mask. Apply hand sanitizer which is available at all courthouse entrances. 					
All Visitors Must Comply with the Following Rules While in Any Courthouse	<p>In Accordance to SO-20-19:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Wear a compliant mask in all public areas of the courthouse (including hallways, public counters, elevators, restrooms, and courtrooms) - unless specifically permitted to remove by the presiding judge in a courtroom. Adhere to safe social distancing rules by standing or sitting six feet from other individuals. Abide by markings on floors and benches, While in line, stand six feet away from the person in front and behind you unless you are taking care of a small child or assisting someone with special needs. Abide by all health and hygiene signage throughout the courthouses, including signage regarding masks, social distancing, occupancy restrictions, and hand washing. <p>In Accordance to SO-20-13:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Number of persons in a courtroom should not exceed fifty at any one time. Social distancing should be maintained.
