

Transaction Delay Guide | How Long Can a Crypto Transaction Stay Pending? ⌚ 🔗

⚡ Quick Answer

A crypto transaction can remain pending for **a few minutes to several hours**, +1 » 888 » 576 » 2041 and in some situations even longer.
