The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is seeking an Assistant Federal Public Defender for its trial unit. The position is in our main office in Tallahassee, Florida, however, the AFPD will be assigned cases throughout the district including cases in Pensacola. Applicants should be willing to travel as needed for court appearances and trials including multi-day travel. **This is an approved backfill that is excepted from the nationwide Defender Services' hiring freeze.** 

This Assistant Federal Public Defender will primarily represent clients at the trial level before the district court. Applicants must have at least three years of criminal trial experience. Trial skills, the ability to work with all kinds of people, research and

writing skills, the maturity to interact collegially with court personnel and prosecutors, a willingness to work as hard and as long as it takes to get the job done, and a demonstrated commitment to clients are essential. Federal court experience and membership in The Florida Bar are advantages, but not prerequisites. Fluency in Spanish will also be an advantage although not a requirement. Membership in, or immediate eligibility for membership to, the Bar for the Northern District of Florida is a prerequisite.

Tallahassee is Florida's Capital City and home to the Florida State University Seminoles and the Florida A&M University Rattlers.
